College:

Unattached/Open/Club Athletes - \$50 Per Athlete

High School:

Teams - **\$325 Per school Per gender. Incomplete Teams (4 or Less) - \$50.00 Per Athlete • Complete Teams (Minimum 5 Athletes; - \$325 per gender.**

MEET DAY PROCEDURES

PACKET PICK-UP:

Team Packets will be available beginning at 3:00 PM on race day, The packets will include meet information, final instructions, competition numbers, etc.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the individual winner in each race, as well as top 10 medels in each race.

PARKING

Parking will be \$10 a car, so please encourage your athletes and parents to car pool. Please have cash available.

WHERE TO PARK

Attached is a map of River Oaks Golf Course. You will enter in at the normal entrance to the golf course, and then you will exit out at Ceres River Bluff Regional Park. Bus drop off will be in front of the club house, and then they can park over at Ceres River Bluff Regional Park or at any of the local shopping centers.

ADMISSIONS/CONCESSIONS:

No charge for spectators.

Concessions will be available the day of the meet.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **Medical/Athletic Trainers:** Stanislaus Athletic Trainers will have a training area that will be open one hour before the start of the first race (6:00pm) (for college athletes only)
- **Showers:** There are NO dressing or shower facilities at the golf course. Meet management encourages all teams to make use of the facilities available at their hotel.
