

2023 Glenn Poole Invitational

The **17th ANNUAL GLENN POOLE INVITATIONAL** is coming early this year. We hope that your program will join us as we host this classic event on **February 25th**. Our event will give athletes an early season chance to evaluate their performance and set goals for the season.

Our facility features two pole vault pits, 2 discus and 2 shot rings, 3 horizontal jump runways, a nine-lane track, and will be timed by Red Cap Timing. In order to keep the meet at a reasonable size, we will be limiting the number of accepted schools. All entries will be submitted online through MileSplit.

Location: Oakmont High School, 1710 Cirby Way, Roseville, CA

Format: We will offer the standard track and field events in all four classifications – Frosh/Soph Boys & Girls, and Varsity Boys & Girls. Each school will be allowed three (3) entries in all individual events (4 in the 1600 and 3200). In the relays (**DMR, 4x100 & 4x400**) teams will be allowed one (1) entry per school per division. Field Events will begin at 8:30 am. Running events will begin at 9:00am. The 3200 is scheduled near the start of the meet and the 1600 is scheduled near the end of the meet.

Kids Half-Lapper: Following the 4x100s, we will host our very popular kids half-lapper. This is **FREE** to enter for all kids 10 and under. A ribbon will be awarded to each finisher. Kids 5 and under will only run 100 meters.

Thrower's 4x100: Prior to the 4x400 relay, we will host our popular "Thrower's" 4x100. These can be coed teams, but should consist entirely of throwers - no ringers!

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) overall finishers in each event.

Important Race Day Info

We are very excited to host you and your team. Our snack bar is being rebuilt. I was hoping that construction would be farther along by now. Unfortunately this has impacted: our parking lot, the entrance gate, food truck location, and how teams/ spectators navigate their way to the visitor side stands. All other aspects of the invitational will continue without any problems.

Parking is limited. Please try to bring the whole family in 1 car. Coaches and athletes are encouraged to carpool.

Buses: Please have buses drop off athletes at the stadium or in front of school. **ALL BUSES must park down the street at Maidu Park** located at 1550 Maidu Dr, Roseville, CA 95661

Everyone entering the stadium must have a **wristband**. Coaches and athletes will be given 1 color. Spectators will be given a separate color. Everyone is expected to keep their wristband on for the day to allow you to go through the gates without problems. We are asking that the whole team enter together OR coaches meet your athletes outside the gate with wrist bands. No one will be allowed through without a wristband. Please respond by 2/21 with how many coaches wristbands you need.

Teams will enter the double wide gate starting at **7 am - 8 am**.

Warm Ups start at 7:30 am

Coaches Meeting at 8 am at the Coaches Hospitality Tent located behind the bathrooms

Field Events start at 8:30 am

Running Event start at 9:00 am

Ticket booth is out in front of the main gate.

Food trucks will be located outside the entrance gate near the construction. Tables and chairs will be available for a food court experience.

We will place short barricades around the curves of the track. Spectators, coaches, and athletes are not allowed to cross the track anywhere except at the hill by the 400 start line. Spectators / teams are allowed to set up on the bark area surrounding the 200 curve. The walkway must remain clear for people to freely access the bathrooms and visitor side stands.

At **FIRST call** athletes are expected to check in at the tent and warm up on the athletic fields behind home-side stands. Check in tent is at the top of the hill. At **SECOND call** athletes will be escorted down from the check in tent to a gated warm up area. When athletes are done competing they are expected to leave the infield. The infield is for athletes competing at their field events or in the gated warm up area. Athletes not following this rule will be disqualified by their bib number.

Entry Fees: Entry fees for each classification:

3 Divisions \$225

2 Divisions \$185

1 Division \$100 (8 or more athletes)

Smaller schools may enter individual athletes at a rate of \$10.00, and Relays \$15
