Granite Bay High School is pleased to host the 11th Annual Randall Sturgeon Invitational on Saturday, March 14, 2026. The meet will be held on our all-weather track and will utilize a FinishLynx timing system.

Results will be posted on Athletic.net following the meet.

Gates will not open until 7:00 AM (per GBHS Athletic Director). Only the Main Gate will be open; no other entrances will be available.

Four divisions of competition: Varsity Boys, Varsity Girls, Frosh/Soph Boys, Frosh/Soph Girls

Each school may enter: 3 athletes per event, 4 athletes in the 1600m and 3200m, 1 relay team per relay (4x100, 4x400)

All field event athletes in the throws and horizontal jumps will receive four attempts.

Team Fees

- 1 Division: \$100
- 2 Divisions: \$190
- 3 Divisions: \$280
- All 4 Divisions: \$375

Entry fees are due by March 14, 2026 and may be brought to the meet.

General Schedule

- Field Event Warm-ups: 7:30 AM
- Field Events Begin: 8:30 AM (flights in all events)
- Running Events Begin: 9:00 AM (rolling schedule; events will not be held)

Please ensure athletes arrive on time and are ready to compete.

A detailed Schedule of Events will be sent by February 10th (or earlier) as we make minor adjustments to improve meet flow and efficiency.

Volunteer Discount

Schools able to assist with event staffing (Pole Vault, High Jump, Long/Triple Jump, Shot Put, Discus) may qualify for a reduced entry fee.

Awards

- Custom medals: 1st–3rd place
- Ribbons: 4th–6th place
- Team plaques: 1st place in each division

Field event awards will be distributed at the event site.

Running event awards may be picked up in the Press Box at the conclusion of the meet. Medal packets will be released to coaches only.

Hospitality & Medical

- Coaches' hospitality (breakfast items) will be located under the home bleachers.
- A full snack bar will be available.
- Athletic Trainer: Near the shed at the end of the home bleachers.

Tent Placement & Team Areas

- Spectator tents must be placed at the top of the bleachers.
- No tents near the press box or in restricted areas (marked with yellow caution tape).

No pop-up tents in the Discus Bleachers.

- Team base camps and warm-up hurdles will be on the soccer field behind the home bleachers. This area provides ample space for warm-ups and stretching while allowing maximum seating for spectators.

Parking (New for 2026)

Granite Bay High School Athletics will charge \$5 cash per vehicle to park in the front lot.

There will be three events on campus that day:

- Sturgeon Invitational
- Grizzly Boys Volleyball Tournament
- Speech & Debate Tournament

Parking Fee Details:

- \$5 cash per entry.

- Re-entry requires paying the fee again.

Drop-Off & Buses

- Buses and vehicle drop-offs will use the designated drop-off zone in front of the school on Wellington Way.
- No vehicles may park in this area; they must drop off and immediately exit.
- Buses will park along Wellington Drive after dropping off in the designated drop-off zone.

Coaches & Officials Parking

- Park in the Library and overflow staff lots on the back side of campus (Pond entrance).
- GBHS administration will monitor access.
- Coaches must present a school ID or be listed on their Athletics.net coaching roster.
- Approximately 110 spaces are available.

Carpooling is strongly encouraged. Please inform families, boosters, and athletes of the cash-only parking fee. A detailed parking map will be sent closer to the meet by the Athletic Director.

Note: Fiesta Park behind the school will host Little League games, and the gate between Fiesta Park and GBHS will be locked.

We look forward to hosting a fast, well-run, and exciting meet.
